

Merry Christmas Crazy Quilt Stocking

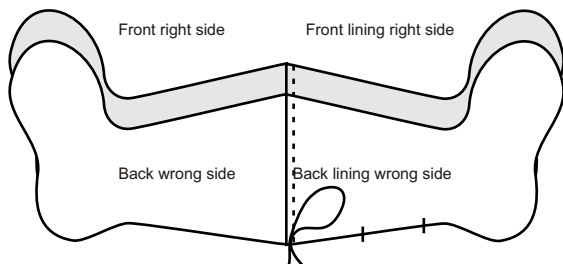
Print this design directly onto computer printer fabric with your inkjet printer. Use it as the foundation for your crazy quilt Christmas stocking with the center image already in place.

To use this foundation pattern, align the edge of your fabric with the dotted line. Sew on the straight line. Flip and press toward the dotted line. Stitch three pieces of fabric together (6-1, 6-2, then add 6-3). Treat as one piece of fabric for 6. Applique the heel and toe (7 and 8).

Embellish the seams. Add embroidered or appliqued holly leaves and berries. Transfer the text using your favorite method. Embroider the text using a stem or outline stitch.

To finish your stocking, cut one lining piece using this pattern. Reverse the pattern, then cut another lining piece and a back. Sew the front lining to the front and the back lining to back at the top with the right sides together. Press the seam towards the lining and topstitch.

Add a cord or fabric hanging loop at the back edge at the seam. With the front and back right sides together, sew around the stocking leaving 4" opening in the lining side to turn. Clip the curves and turn right side out. Stitch the opening closed with a blind hem stitch. Push the lining down inside of the stocking. Press gently.

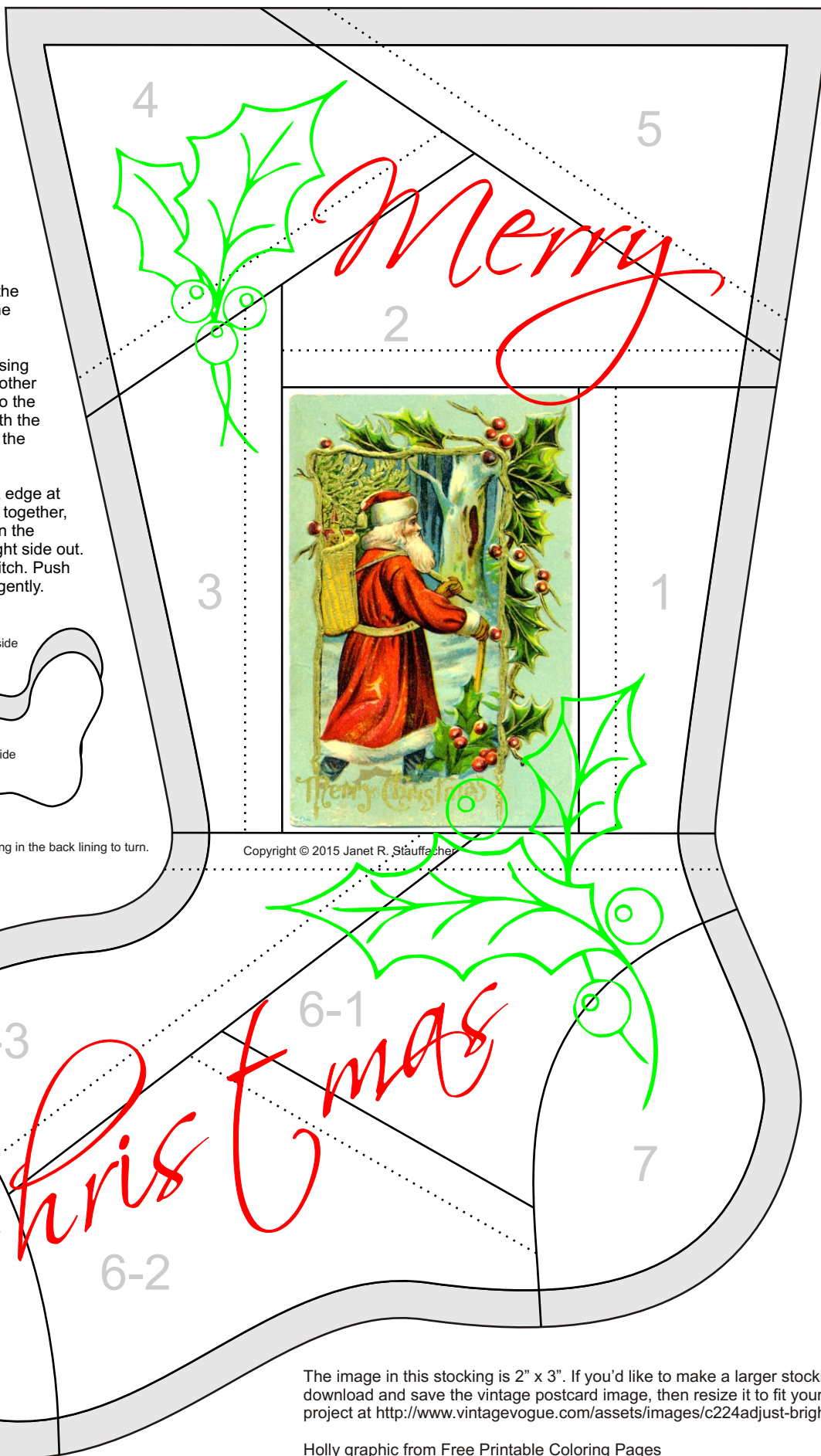


Add a hanging loop before sewing closed. Leave a 4" opening in the back lining to turn.

Enjoy your crazy quilt stocking!
